

The scope of work consists of removing and replacing submersible pumps, plumbing and electrical at Three (3) Existing Lift Stations. All perspective bidders shall obtain a copy of the book no later than two working days prior to bid opening date. No refunds will be made.

A CERTIFIED OR CASHIER'S CHECK, or an acceptable bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid shall accompany each bid as a guaranty that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will promptly enter into contract with the City of McGehee, Arkansas and furnish bonds on the forms provided.

Bidders as well as all subcontractors that may be acquired or used are expected to have an active Unique Entity Identifier Number through [www.sam.gov](http://www.sam.gov) the day of bid opening.

The owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. Bidders may not withdraw their bids within 30 days after the date of bid opening and must provide bid bonds as required. All bidding processes shall be in accordance with State law.

**Instruction to Bidders**

The following information is specific to prospective bidders of ACEDP-funded construction projects:

**BUY AMERICA PREFERENCE**

The Build America Buy America Act provides, to the greatest extent possible, for early coordination with engineers/architects to incorporate products that meet Buy America Preference in the design phase of infrastructure projects. All contractors who receive federal financial assistance for an infrastructure project which includes construction, alterations, or repairs are subject to the BABA unless a waiver is in place.

The Buy America Preference (BAP) requires the use of iron and steel, construction materials and manufactured goods produced in the United States. Bidders must provide cost estimates based on the most current American made products available. The Buy America Preference must be included in all subawards, contracts, and purchase orders for the work performed, or products supplied under an ACEDP award.

**1. Receipt and Opening of Bids**

The City of McGehee, Arkansas (herein identified as "Owner"), invites bids on the forms attached hereto, all blanks of which must be appropriately filled in. Bids will be received by the Owner at the office of Mayor Jeff Owyong 901 Holly Street McGehee, Arkansas 71654 until two (2) o'clock p.m., CST on February 26, 2026(*Date*), and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed to City of McGehee, Arkansas Mayor Jeff Owyong 901 Holly Street McGehee, Arkansas 71654 and designated as Bid for Lift Station Improvements.

The Owner may consider informal any bid not prepared and submitted in accordance with the provisions hereof and may waive any informalities or scheduled time for bid opening or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No bidder may withdraw a bid within **30 days** after the actual date of bid opening.

**2. Preparation of Bid**

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form **and must be accompanied by completed Certification of Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity and Contractor Section 3 Certification forms**. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, in both words and figures.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside the name of the bidder, his address, and the name of the project for which the bid is submitted.
