

NOTICE TO BIDDERS OF THE INTENTION OF McCURTAIN COUNTY RURAL WATER DISTRICT NO.8 TO LET A CONTRACT FOR WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE MT. FORK RESORT PHASE II DEVELOPMENT.

SEALED PROPOSALS addressed to Randy McMurl, Manager, McCurtain Co. RWD 8, 1803 N US Hwy 259, Broken Bow, Oklahoma 74728, will be received until 2 P.M., Wednesday July 15, 2026 for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, supplies, and supervision necessary for the construction of 4-inch HDPE water mains associated with the Mt. Fork Resort Phase II Development. Bids will be opened and read aloud at such time at the McCurtain Co. RWD 8 Water Office, 1803 N US Hwy 259, Broken Bow, Oklahoma.

A CERTIFIED OR CASHIER'S CHECK, or an acceptable bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid shall accompany each bid as a guaranty that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will promptly enter into contract with RWD #8 and furnish bonds on the forms provided.

THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER OR BIDDERS will be required to furnish a Performance, Payment, and Maintenance Bond, each in the amount of the contract, written by a responsible surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oklahoma that is satisfactory to the Owner.

BIDDERS ARE expected to inspect the site of the work and to inform themselves of all local conditions. The time of completion shall be 90 calendar days including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

ATTENTION OF BIDDERS is directed to Section 4 of Act 74 of 1969, requiring that not less than the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for work of similar character in the locality where the work is performed shall be paid all laborers, workmen and mechanics employed in the construction of public works.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN EMPLOYMENT: All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER will be required to furnish evidence of registration with the State Department of Finance and Administration in compliance with Act 125 of 1965 prior to engaging in the performance of this Contract.

NO BID may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least 60 calendar days.

IN CASE of ambiguity or lack of clearness stating the price in the bids, McCurtain Co. RWD #8 reserves the right to consider the most advantageous construction thereof, or to reject the bid.

MCCURTAIN RURAL WATER DISTRICT #8 reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any minor informalities, and to award the contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

CONTRACTORS are cautioned that qualified bids will be subject to rejection.

CONTRACTORS are specifically advised that any person, firm, or other party to whom it is proposed to award a subcontract under this contract must be acceptable to the Owner.
